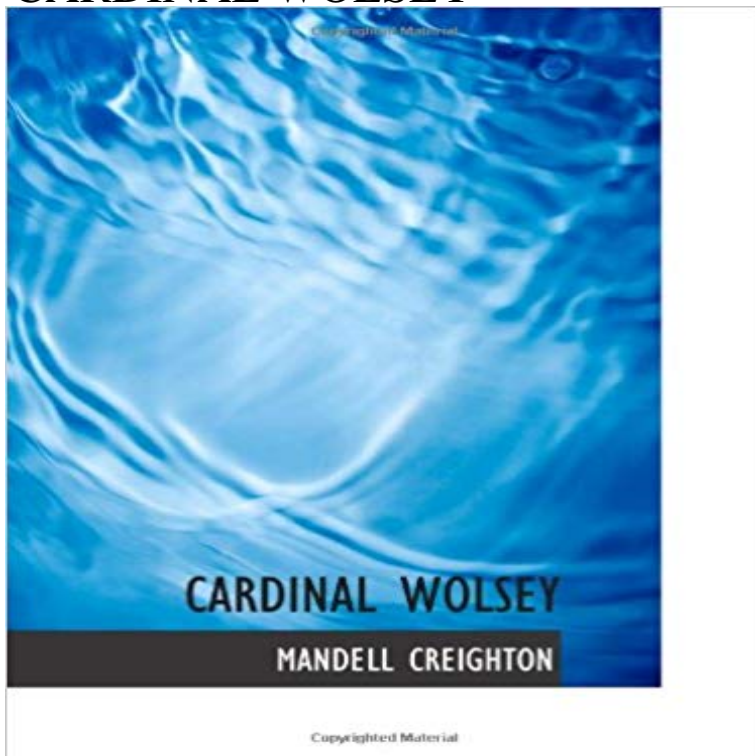


## CARDINAL WOLSEY
