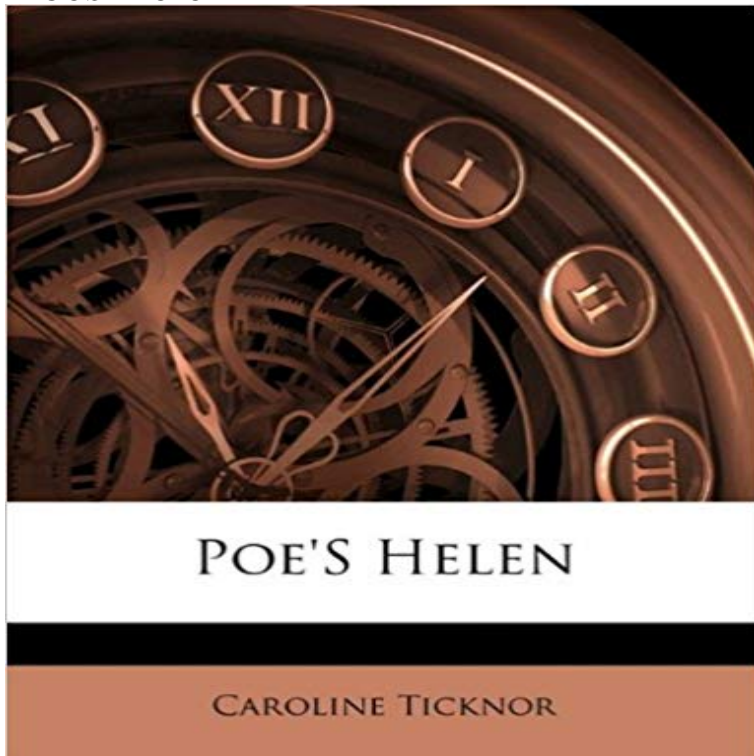


Poes Helen
