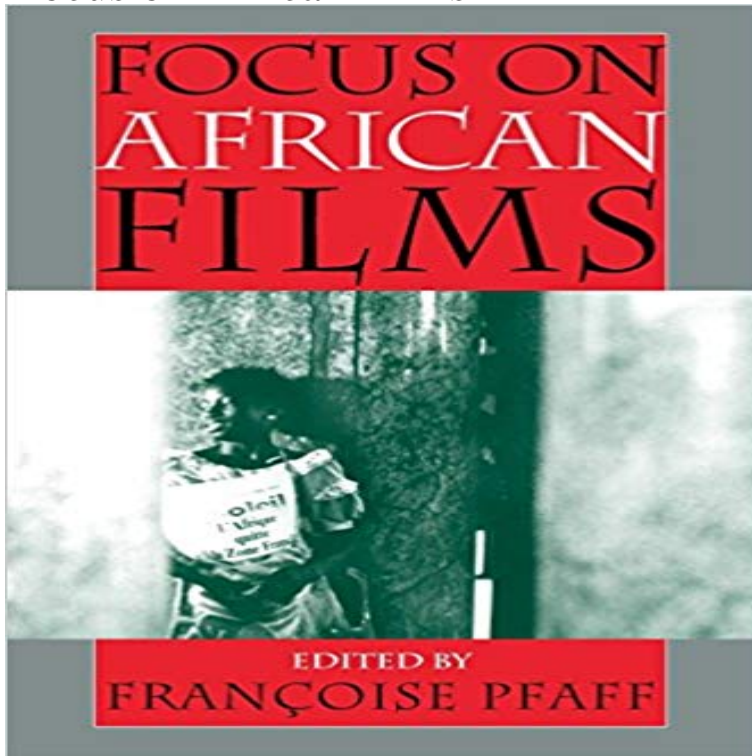


## Focus on African Films
