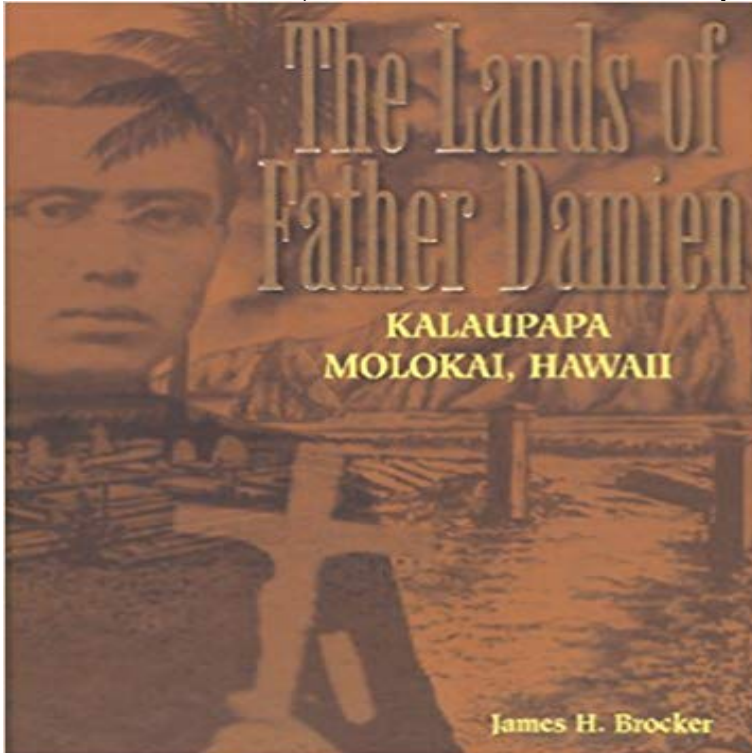


Father Damien, The Lands of: Kalaupapa, Molokai, Hawaii
