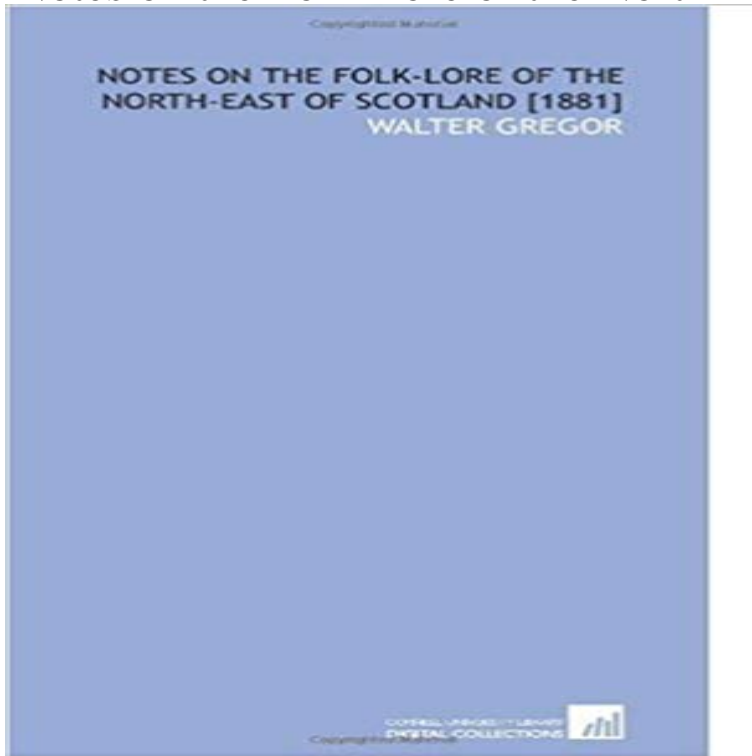


Notes on the Folk-Lore of the North-East of Scotland [1881]
