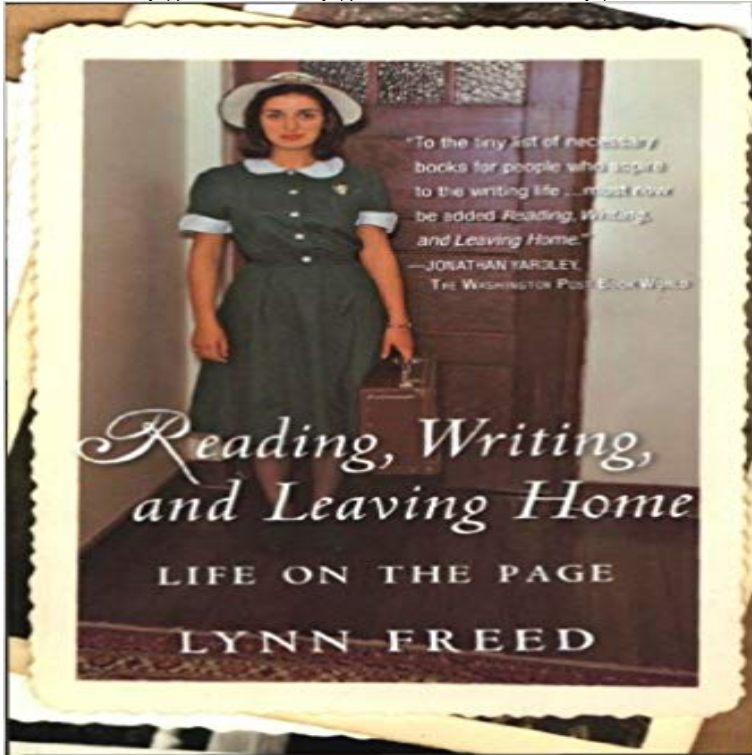


Reading, Writing, and Leaving Home: Life on the Page
