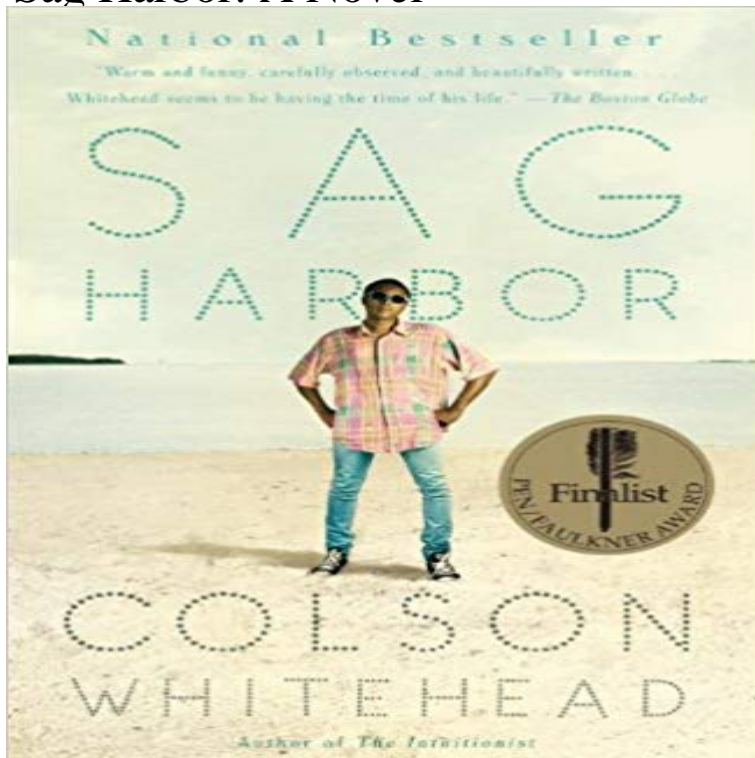


## Sag Harbor: A Novel
