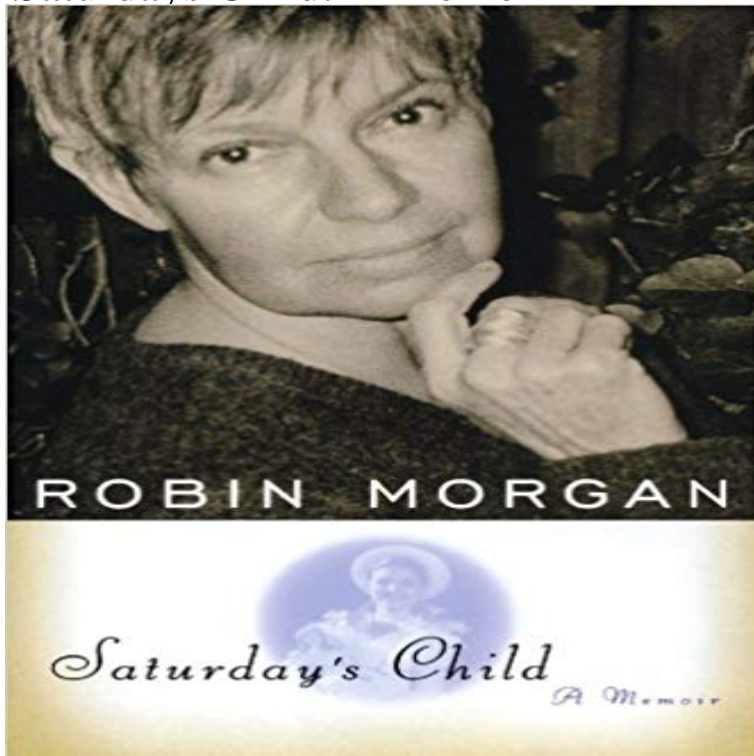


## Saturdays Child: A Memoir
