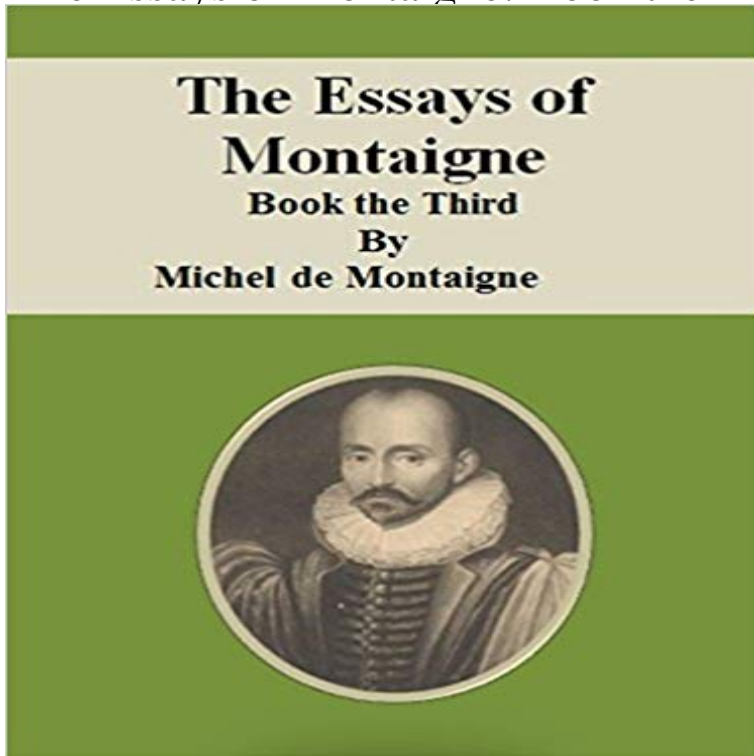


## The Essays of Montaigne: Book the Third
