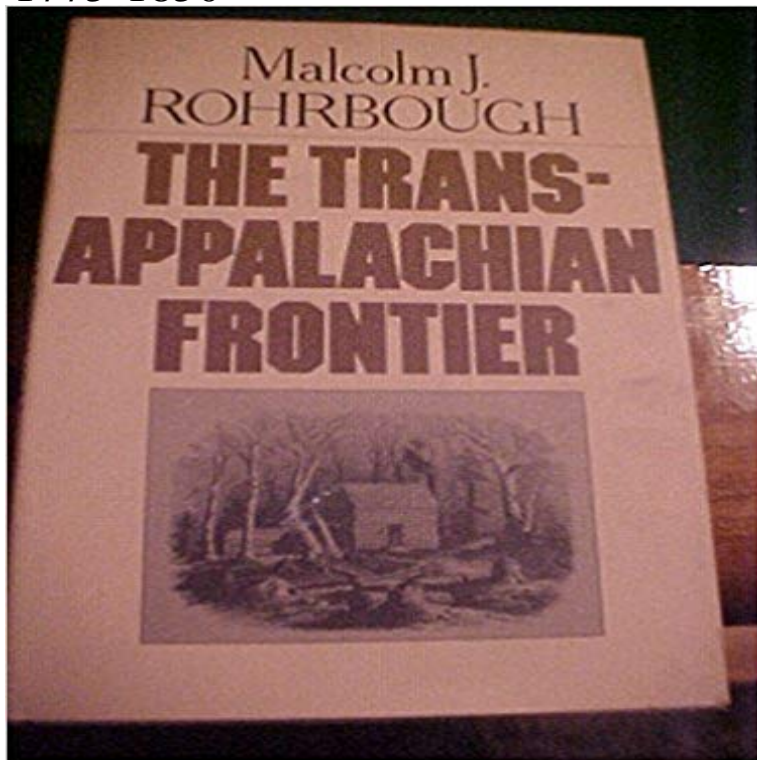


The Trans-Appalachian Frontier: People, Societies, and Institutions, 1775-1850
