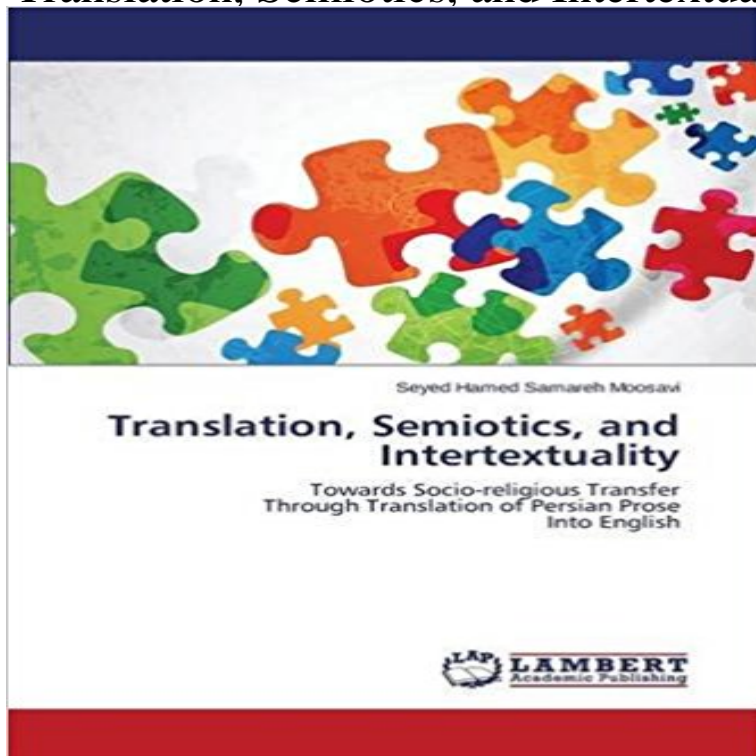


Translation, Semiotics, and Intertextuality
